

ACTIVITY DAY FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2019

Great News... West Hants students have the opportunity once again, to expand their horizons by trying out a new activity during our Winter Carnival Activity Day. Here's how it works: Students will sign up for the activity of their choice on **Wednesday, January 30th, 2019 (Storm Date: Jan 31st)**. Homerooms will be randomly drawn. We will alternate between grade eights and sevens first, followed by the sixes. Space will be reserved on a **first pay, first served** basis.

Tips for a successful Sign up Day:

1. **Have money and this form, completed and SIGNED BY PARENTS, (on last page), with you on the day of sign up, Jan. 30th.** Cheques can be made payable to West Hants Middle School. **(Postdated cheques will not be accepted).**
Please ensure that you have enough money to cover the most expensive activity within your 3 choices.
2. On this form, make 3 choices of activities...and number them in order of preference as an event may be full by the time you sign up. Number 1 would be your first choice.
3. Remember that bussing costs have been factored into the price.
4. All waiver forms must be returned to the office by Tuesday, Feb. 12th or you may lose your spot.
5. **THESE VENUES AND BUSES ARE PREPAID. THEREFORE WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO REFUND MONEY UNLESS IT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY ADMINISTRATION.**

ACTIVITY CHOICES

1. **Bayers Lake:** **Kart Bahn Racing** (30 spots available) **Cost: \$35**

Students will have the opportunity to show their racing prowess. Each student will have **three racing sessions. Each session will be timed.** In the "off season" you can watch others race, if you can stand the excitement. **Students will need to bring a lunch.** Additional waiver to be picked up and **completed online before trip day.**

2. **Windsor:** **Ski Martock** (30 packages) **Cost: Package price**

Students will have a great day enjoying one of the many activities offered at the hill- snowboarding, or down hill skiing. Please note...there will be a bus taking students to the hill, however all students **MUST** arrange their own transportation home from the hill. There **will not be a bus returning** to the school. **Students must have a waiver form signed which can be picked up at sign up or on-line at www.martock.com.** Waivers must be printed in color. 3. **Windsor:** **WHMS & Bowling** (30 spots available) **Cost: \$10**

Students will enjoy a morning at West Hants either in the gym, the games room or watching a movie. Then jump on the bus at 11:45, and head to the bowling alley in Windsor. Students can enjoy a slice of pizza and pop (included in price) prior to bowling with friends. They may wish to bring extra money to buy additional treats at the bowling alley.

4. Ardoise: Serenity Acres Family Ranch (20 spots available) Cost: \$25

“Giddy up!” Students will have the opportunity to enjoy some horse-human interaction or horsemanship, through hands-on interactive challenges including grooming, leading, and obstacles on the ground. Come dressed warmly!! There will also be a **swim time** put into the rotation, so be sure to bring your swimsuit!! Students must bring their own food and drinks. Additional waiver to be picked up at sign-up.

5. Canning: Paintball @ Storm Warning Paintball Games (40 spots available) Cost: \$35

Students will enjoy a day of paintball fun...Students will receive 500 paintballs plus equipment. All equipment must be rented. **No personal paintball guns are permitted on school bus.** All games will be inside. Wear old warm clothing. Dressing in layers is suggested. Students are encouraged to bring lunch along with snacks and lots of drinks. Students will only be allowed to participate if they have a liability release form signed, which can be picked up at sign up. Students **MUST** have a change of clothes for the bus ride home; paintballs are not to be brought back to school.

Enjoy a movie with your friends at Sackville Cineplex. The movie will be a new release, and must be rated PG. The title will be announced the Tuesday, prior to activity day. 7. Dartmouth: Get Air Trampoline Park (190 spots available) Cost: \$20

8. ICE All Stars Cheer and Gymnastics Gym Windsor (20 spots) Cost: \$10

Visit ICE All Stars Cheer and Gymnastics Gym for a few fun hours of flipping and tumbling with our certified instructors. A 30 foot trampoline, foam landing pit, and a variety of gymnastics equipment make it a fun and safe place to learn to flip and tumble.
